The final decision that day was to start a Newsletter to keep our members informed as to luncheon venues and menus. The Newsletters were printed at Staples and distributed to the members by a group of volunteers.

I am happy to report that they have agreed to take up the baton from me and start editing and distributing the monthly newsletters starting with June.

Therefore, I say goodbye to you all as the editor of this very important communication tool. I will always be a member of this Club and hope to continue to be active. Many thanks to all of you who shared your family events, to our many Presidents who have worked with me and all those who took the time to respond to our events which were highlighted in our Newsletter it was most appreciated and made this task an easy one.


