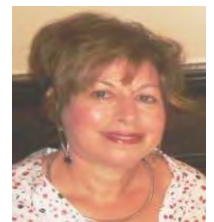

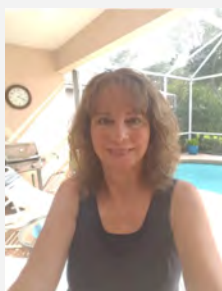

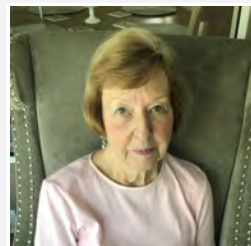

She serves on the Leadership Council of the SunCoast Partnership to End Homelessness. Most recently, she received the Unity Award from Sarasota Magazine for work to bring inclusion and equality to our community. In her free time, she enjoys teaching Origami and has displayed some of her work at The Ringling Museum. Her life cue is from the Japanese philosophy of "ikigai" which means "find joy in life through purpose."

Second Heart Homes has 7 homes that serve individuals coming off the streets with a mental health condition. Currently there are 12 women in the program.

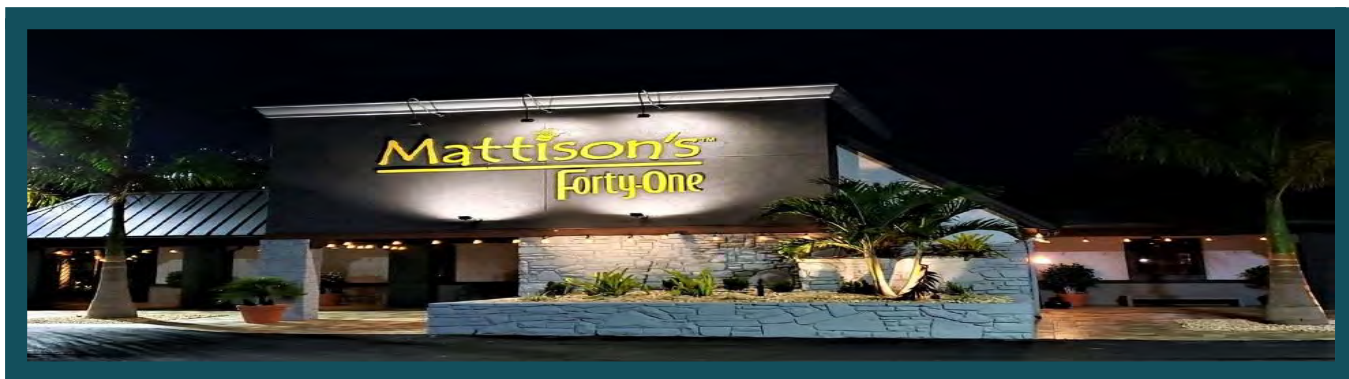


