On The Grounds

COCOPLUM (CHRYSOBALANUS ICACO)

Cocoplum, a South Florida native, is an outstanding evergreen plant with a "beachy" look, producing an edible plum which many creatures enjoy. Terrific as a hedge or privacy plants, these multi-stemmed, woody shrubs can grow to about 15 feet - though most of the time they're kept trimmed to around 4 feet. The cocoplum takes some effort to get established, but once it is growing well it is an easy-care plant that is salt-tolerant and needs little irrigation. This dense evergreen with shiny, leathery leaves can be kept more manicured for a formal look or left to grow in its naturally pretty rounded shape in a casual landscape style.




