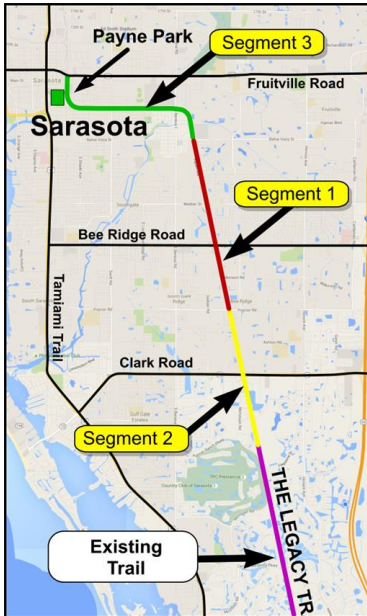

Palmer Ranch Park Updates



LEGACY TRAIL EXTENSION

Legacy Trail Extension includes:

- Segment 1 – Proctor Rd to Bahia Vista w/Webber St Trailhead
- Segment 2 – North terminus at Culverhouse Nature Park to Proctor Rd w/Ashton Rd Trailhead
- Segment 3 - Bahia Vista to Ringling Blvd w/Pompano Trailhead

Work is occurring in all three segments. Trail will extend from Culverhouse Nature Park to downtown Sarasota/Fruitville Rd. with connection to North Port. There will be three new trailheads; one at Ashton Rd., one at Webber St. and one at Pompano Ave.

Construction should be completed in 2022. In late 2023, overpasses at Clark Road and Bee Ridge Road will be constructed by FDOT.

CULVERHOUSE NATURE PARK RESTROOM PROJECT

Restroom design is the same design that was created for the Legacy Trail Extension project to have coordinated architectural styles along the Legacy Trail. The project is now being permitted and should be completed in 2021.

BAY STREET PAW PARK

The project should be under construction in late 2020 or early 2021 and should be completed in 2021 barring any hurricanes, additional slow down due to COVID 19, or other unforeseen events.

OSPREY JUNCTION TRAILHEAD RESTROOM PROJECT

Restroom design is the same design that was created for the Legacy Trail Extension project to have coordinated architectural styles along the Legacy Trail. The project is now being permitted and should be completed in 2021.

SCHERER THAXTON PRESERVE

Restroom and fishing pier project has been placed on hold until 2021.

WINTER ANNUALS

A seasonal tradition on Palmer Ranch is the changing of the annuals. Winter brings forth striking beds of Geraniums. Soils will be modified at each of the Palmer Ranch entrances in preparation for the installation of the winter plantings. The design features full beds of Red Patriot Geraniums. Planting the annuals in late November/early December allows the plants to “harden in” before the colder weather arrives.

The Patriot Geranium feature lightly scented crimson flowers which mature to about 24-30” tall and spread anywhere from one to two feet. They prefer moist but well-drained soil. We trim back, or pinch off, the old blooms which prompts the plant to send out new blooms which is why the Geraniums look beautiful all the way to the spring planting of Sunpatiens.
