2023 CALENDAR YEAR – MASTER ASSOCIATION BUDGET APPROVED

In meeting of September 22nd, the Master Association 2023 calendar year budget was approved by the Board of Trustees. The Master Association 2023 Assessment for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 will remain unchanged at \$167.00 per assessable unit value. Turning Points is a non-profit organization that provides hope and assistance to men, women and children who are at risk of being homeless or are homeless.

Friends of Osprey Junction Trailhead e-Bike Battery Recycling Program

Research shows that more than 12 million electric bicycles (e-bikes) are estimated to be sold in the United States between 2020 and 2030. That's 12 million batteries used to power those e-bikes that will need to be safely and responsibly collected and recycled at their end-of-life. With this in mind, Friends of Osprey Junction Trailhead has announced an e-bike Battery Recycling Program.

Partnering with Call2Recycle, the country's leading consumer battery recycling and stewardship program (www.call2recycle.org) and local bike shops participating in the program, Friends of Osprey Junction Trailhead is excited to add this e-bike battery recycling program to its existing community services and programs.




