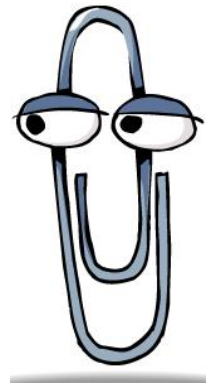


# *Turtle Rock Organizations and Contact Information at a Glance*
